

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-002

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 35-011 OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF KILLDEER, NORTH DAKOTA, RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT AND REENACTMENT OF PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE CITY'S SALES, USE, AND GROSS RECEIPTS TAX, AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLDEER, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 35-011, entitled "Sales, Use, and Gross Receipts Tax", is hereby amended and re-enacted as follows:

Dedication of Tax Proceeds.

The proceeds from the sales and use taxes imposed by this chapter shall be used as follows: One half percent (1/2%) for the operation and maintenance of the Killdeer Aquatics and Wellness Center; One half percent (1/2%) for the operation and maintenance of the Killdeer Parks and Recreation; One half percent (1/2%) for the operation and maintenance of the Dunn County Golf Association, and One half percent (1/2%) to assist area organizations and causes promoting community development related to community needs in the areas of health, recreation, security, economic development, and senior services; for a total of two percent (2%) total sales and use tax imposed.

Termination Date.

The power of the City to [impose] continue a city sales tax, shall be submitted to a vote of the qualified voters at a special municipal election in [2025]2035. If a majority of the qualified voters do not vote to continue the tax in effect, it shall cease to be imposed and collected on June 30th following.

Section 2: Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 3: Severability. In the event any section of this Ordinance is held invalid by court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall extend only to the section affected, and other sections of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after final passage.
