MARCH 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 SPECIAL ELECTION

Canvas Board Member Logan Wallace called the City of Killdeer Canvas Board Meeting for the March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Special Election to order. Canvas Board Members present were Logan Wallace, Cindy Hanson, Chris Fenstermaker Greg Nordsvan, and Matt Oase with City Attorney Nate Bouray present via conference call.

Canvas Board members Logan Wallace, Chris Fenstermaker, Cindy Hanson, Greg Nordsvan, and Matt Oase performed their Canvas Board Oath of Office.

Canvas Board Member Nordsvan moved to designate Logan Wallace as Canvas Board Chairman and Cindy Hanson as Canvas Board Recorder, seconded by Canvas Board Member Fenstermaker. On a roll call vote, all voted aye. M/C

Canvas Board Member Fenstermaker moved to certify the final vote totals of the March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Special Election, seconded by Canvas Board Member Nordsvan. On a roll call vote, all voted aye. M/C

The following is the official vote totals for the City of Killdeer March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Special Election as Officially Certified by the Killdeer Canvas Board:

**Ballot Measure:**

The purpose of the Special Election: Shall the City of Killdeer Home Rule Charter be amended to continue the current sales, use, and gross receipts tax for 10 years, and adjust the allocation of the proceeds to include a one half percent tax to fund the operation and maintenance of the Killdeer Aquatics & Wellness Center, one half percent tax to fund the operation and maintenance of the Dunn County Golf Association, one half percent tax to fund the operation and maintenance of the Killdeer Parks and Recreation, and one half percent tax to fund area organizations and causes promoting community development related to community needs in the areas of health, recreation, security, economic development, and senior services, commencing July 1, 2025 for a period of ten years?

**Official Results:**

- YES: 127 Votes
- NO: 26 Votes
